Art of Knowledge Exchange Workshop

The workshop is targeted to practitioners who are currently engaged in connecting clients to global knowledge for better and faster development results or are interested in doing so in the future. It focuses on peer-peer knowledge exchange practices and techniques, recognizing that countries and institutions want to learn from peers who have overcome similar real-world challenges. The workshop will be beneficial both to institutions that are involved in knowledge exchange as knowledge and solution providers or as knowledge brokers.

This workshop, based on The Art of Knowledge Exchange planning guide, focuses on the tools needed to design effective knowledge exchange initiatives. It introduces and provides hands-on experience with a systematic model which can easily be applied to improve results of a range of knowledge exchange initiatives. Participants will learn how to identify the various instruments that can be used for knowledge exchange, and how to choose the ones best suited to achieving desired objectives and results. These will be covered using a case involving titling of indigenous peoples land rights in Latin America. Small group discussions during the session will link the knowledge exchange case to broader knowledge exchange issues and challenges.
