Rediscover GNP, The Sound of Blooming

The theme for the 2018 Taichung World Flora Exposition is Rediscover GNP, which redefines the economic indicator GNP (Gross National Product) as Green, Nature, and People. This symbolizes three important values for harmonious development - ecology, production and life. It is hoped that in the pursuit of output value that people cherish this land, take time out of their busy schedules to enjoy nature, listen to the sounds of blooming flowers and create a happier, more fulfilled life.

The Taichung World Flora EXPO takes place across three exhibition areas in Houli, Waipu and Fengyuan districts. These districts are successful in ecological conservation, flower and fruit growing and waterside floral landscapes, respectively, echoing the spirit of Green, Nature and People.

The green leaf symbolizes an old tree and the century-old horse ranch, as well as the soul-soothing forest park, of the Houli exhibition area. The orange flower represents the rich floral and fruit industries of the Waipu exhibition area, while the flowing blue water brings to mind the waterside floral landscapes of Huludun Park in the Fengyuan exhibition area.

Protecting the environment and the leopard cat Naming of the Taichung World Flora Exposition

In 2014, traces of leopard cat activity were found in the planned Houli exhibition area. Taichung City Mayor Chia-lung Lin prioritized preservation of this habitat, reducing this exhibition area and adding the Waipu and Fengyuan exhibition areas to compensate. In 2015, these actions were recognized by the International Association of Horticultural Producers (AIPH) with an upgrade from the Taichung International Flora Exposition to the Taichung World Flora Exposition. In preparation for this event, the century-old Houli Horse Ranch has undergone extensive renovation, while preserving its historical structures. It is expected to become the largest international-class equestrian competition venue in Asia, increasing exposure to this area and its culture.

Focuses on people and sustainable structures

The Taichung World Flora EXPO is by no means a one-time event to disappear quickly like a fireworks display. With an emphasis on people, the first priority is the planning of exhibition spaces based on a long-term view, meaning sustainable structures for the Taichung World Flora EXPO and beyond. These are to display the achievements of Taiwan's flower and fruit farmers, the life esthetics of horticulturists, and the devotion of volunteers, as well as to showcase the hospitality of Taiwan. The development of transportation, commercial, tourism and cultural facilities also encourages local sustainable development and allows the world to see Taichung and to gain a clearer picture of Taiwan.

The Taichung World Flora EXPO is a world-class, interdisciplinary stage. It brings together people of all fields and ages to present their professional enthusiasm and devotion, as well as to bring exposure to Taichung. Houli Horse Ranch and Forest Park Area

Taiwan's Only Century-old Horse and Flower Paradise

Theme: Horse Ranch and Flower Paradise

Area: 30.04 hectares

Features : Ecosystem, Green, Co-existence

Future Use: Asia's largest equestrian competition venue

Preserves forest flora and fauna, as well as historical horse ranch

/ Exhibition Halls / (Tentative)

Floral Exhibition Hall (including Flower Dance Slope)

International and domestic floral exhibition and competition venue with a focus Discovery Hall

This hall features exhibitions on the connection between this event and leopard cat habitat preservation, as well as on the leopard cat and ecological issues of other endangered species in Taiwan, such as the Formosan black bear and Mikado pheasant. Nature is the focus.

International Standard Equestrian Show Jumping Stadium

This is a fully equipped equestrian competition venue that can accommodate thousands of spectators.

Indigenous Culture Area

This area showcases indigenous handicrafts and modern floriculture to convey the life esthetics of indigenous communities. World music and dance festival and Austronesian music festival are planned for this area.

International Garden Area

This area presents the characteristics of horticultural industry development and the cultures of various countries through attractive exhibitions and a world view.



Waipu Park Area

First Large-scale Exposition on Taiwan's Agricultural Industry

Theme: Flower and Produce Village

Area: 14.32 hectares

Features: Manufacturing, Nature, Sharing

Future Use: International agricultural innovation park

With "agriculture as part of everyday life and sustainable future" as the core topics, this area is focused on Taiwan's past as an agricultural economy, as well as its visions for its present and future.

/ Exhibition Halls / (Tentative)

Nature House

The exhibitions in this hall describe farming community life and culture. The applications of agricultural research achievements to daily life are also presented.

Green Pavilion

Digital technologies highlight smart agricultural applications. In addition, the use of innovative technologies to create a vision for a better life is presented. Moreover, visitors can experience different seasonal plants.











Fengyuan Huludun Park

Longest Waterside Floral Gallery in Taiwan

Theme: Floral Metropolis by the Water

Area: 16.52 hectares

Features : Life, People, Mutual Good

Future Use: Pastry Meseum

In this exhibition area, the vision and history of Taichung's creative life are presented. Visitors can experience pastry making, canoeing lantern festival and artistic performances and exhibitions, as they explore this charming waterside area.

Floral Banquet Hall

The theme of this hall is "flower pastry adventures - flower fairies and apprentices", which introduces Taichung's pastry culture.

Domestic Garden Competition Area

Floral landscape installation competition area.

5th Area Scenic Lake

Recreational activities include canoeing. Along a scenic path are different species of shrubs, as well as flowers and other plants. This is a feast for the eyes every season of the year.
