EPIDEMIOLOGICAL STUDY OF TYPHOID FEVER IN A CHILDREN SHELTER IN SEOUL

ABSTRACT:

For many years, the city of Seoul has been afflicted by numbers of typhoid epidemics, although the scale of each epidemic differed from case to case. Unfortunately, however, there are no comprehensive and reliable reports available for a single case of the epidemics.

A recent out-break of typhoid fever in a children shelter in Seoul is surveyed and the results are summarized as follows:

In the shelter are accommodated 1052 boys and 198 girls. It is comparatively large in size and its facilities are considered to be adequate for the purpose it is intended to serve.

The first report of typhoid fever from the shelter was made on June 2, 1969, in which two cases, Gae Yong, Kim (male, 14 years old), and Gwan Yong, Kim (male, 13 years old) were made known infected. The out-break ended with the total of 42 cases but with a scale. The mortality rate is 21 per 1000 population and the attack
